wine list

Sparkling Wine

- 1 Sunnyclyff Brut Australia NV **£16.95** A good mousse with streams of tiny bubbles. Pale golden colour with a bready nose. Smooth, rich and flavoursome, the creamy palate is offset by fresh, crisp notes giving way to a lingering finish.
- 2 Trivento Sparkling Rosé Argentina NV **£18.50** Made from Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, two of the classic grapes of champagne, the promise is fulfilled in this delicate pink, elegantly balanced wine with a resounding depth of flavour.
- 3 Chapel Down Brut Tenterden, Kent, England NV **£27.50** Pale lemon yellow in colour, the nose is slightly floral with some citrus. A wellstructured wine with hawthorn, citrus and yeasty flavours and a hint of blackcurrant leaves.

Champagne

- 4 Jean Josselin Brut Carte Noir France NV **£33.50** An excellent champagne made principally from Pinot Noir grapes produced in the Côte des Bar in the south of Champagne. A lovely, fruity wine with hints of May blossom, apples, peaches and ripe strawberries.
- 5 Bollinger Special Cuvée Brut France NV **£55.00** Growers and producers from its founding in 1829, and still wholly family owned, 70% of Bollinger's grape supply comes from its own vineyards. This superb Marque carries great depth of flavour and finesse: rich, dry and full flavoured, classic yeasty bread dough, a characteristic peachiness and creamy texture.

Rosé Wine

- 6 Mountain Range Merlot Rosé Chile 2007 quarter bottle **£3.75** Intense pink with bluish and violet hues. A floral nose with red fruits and sour cherries on the palate. A delicious, medium bodied dry wine with great character.
- 7 Navarra Pleno Rosado Spain 2007 **£13.95** An enticing strawberry pink, it is mediumbodied and crisp with an attractive fruity finish.
- 8 Winston Hill Syrah Rosé USA 2007 **£15.95** This is a deliciously easydrinking rosé, with plenty of summer fruit on the nose and palate. A pleasant offdry finish.

White Wine

- 9 Mountain Range Sauvignon Blanc Chile 2007 quarter bottle
£3.75 Classic Chilean Sauvignon, grassy nose and intense gooseberry flavour with apple and pear on the palate providing a fresh, clean, crisp finish.

- 10 Casa Roca Sauvignon Blanc/Semillon Chile 2007 **£13.95**
Fragrant, citrusy nose, crisp and dry with good acidity and refreshing, fruity length.

- 11 Pampas Del Sur Chardonnay/Chenin Argentina 2008
£14.95 Crisp, fruity Chenin combines fabulously with a tropical Chardonnay for a delicious, balanced and easydrinking wine.

- 12 Stellar Organic Fairtrade Chenin/Sauv. Blanc South Africa 2008 **£15.95** Golden yellow. The two grape varieties were vinified separately and aged on the lees before blending. The Chenin provides the guava fruit aromas whilst the Sauvignon gives body and length with a slight grassiness to the taste.

- 13 Redtree Pinot Grigio USA 2007 **£16.95** Flavours of citrus, ripe peaches and pears; briskly refreshing and lasting on the finish.

- 14 Canterbury Choice Pilgrim's Harvest Canterbury, Kent, England 2006 **£17.95** A pleasant floral nose, medium style wine with balanced sweetness and well rounded. Good, clean finish with full and lingering fruit flavours.

- 15 Omahu Road Sauvignon Blanc New Zealand 2007
£18.95 Tropical fruit flavours dominate, but the wine is fresh and lively too; harmonious and easydrinking, whilst elegant and understated, much like 'old world' sauvignon.

- 16 Chablis La Colombe France 2007 **£22.95** No oak, pungent and flinty on the nose with a tad of creamy fruit, getting richer as the mineral characters give way to riper buttery sensations, cut by a long crisp bite.

- 17 Pouilly Fumé Domaine Corneau France 2006 **£24.50** A wellpoised Sauvignon displaying crisp, smoky citrus fruit and a lingering, gooseberry finish.

Red Wine

- 18 Mountain Range Merlot Chile 2007 quarter bottle **£3.75** A deep rubyred with a cherry wood and plummy nose. Heaps of supple, jammy fruit and supersoft tannins. An easy-drinking, mouthfilling wine.
- 19 Casa Roca Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot Chile 2007 **£13.95** Powerful nose of berried fruits. Soft and rounded with plenty of ripe, plummy flavours.
- 20 Rowlands Brook Shiraz/Cabernet Sauvignon Australia 2006 **£14.95** A bouquet of ripe fruit with a smooth, rounded, medium bodied palate bursting with juicy, spicy fruit.
- 21 Stellar Organic Fairtrade Shiraz South Africa 2007 **£15.95** A deep, bricky red with a spicy nose of blackberry, black pepper and jasmine. The palate continues the spicy character and is loaded with cooked stonefruits and fruitcake. A supple finish with a hint of white pepper.
- 22 Redtree Zinfandel USA 2005 **£16.95** Classic briary aromas with a sensationally smooth, glossy palette of vibrant fruit.
- 23 Rioja Vega del Rayo Seleccionada Spain 2006 **£17.95** A delicious, modern style with bags of fruit and a spicy, smoky dimension from six months in oak.
- 24 Canterbury Choice Red Reserve Canterbury, Kent, England 2005 **£19.95** An aromatic, deeply coloured wine. Rich fruit, robust tannins and careful oaking combine to give a satisfyingly long-lasting depth of flavour.
- 25 Fleurie La Reine de l'Arenite France 2007 **£21.00** Intense purple colour, pronounced nose of candied fruit. Soft, fruity and well rounded palate nicely balanced by gentle tannins.
- 26 Crozes Hermitage Domaine Pradelle France 2005 **£24.50** Subtly perfumed nose of pepper, cedar and rose petals; dry, restrained fruit with smooth tannins and a long, firm finish.

The vintages shown are those current when this list was published.

In due course these will be succeeded by the next vintage which will probably, but not certainly, be that of the following year. Please note that each vintage has its own particular character.
