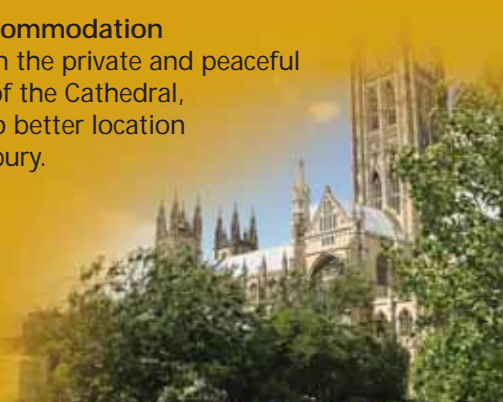

Breakfast for hotel guests is served in the refectory daily and this versatile space is ideal for refreshment, lunch and dinner breaks for conference delegates.



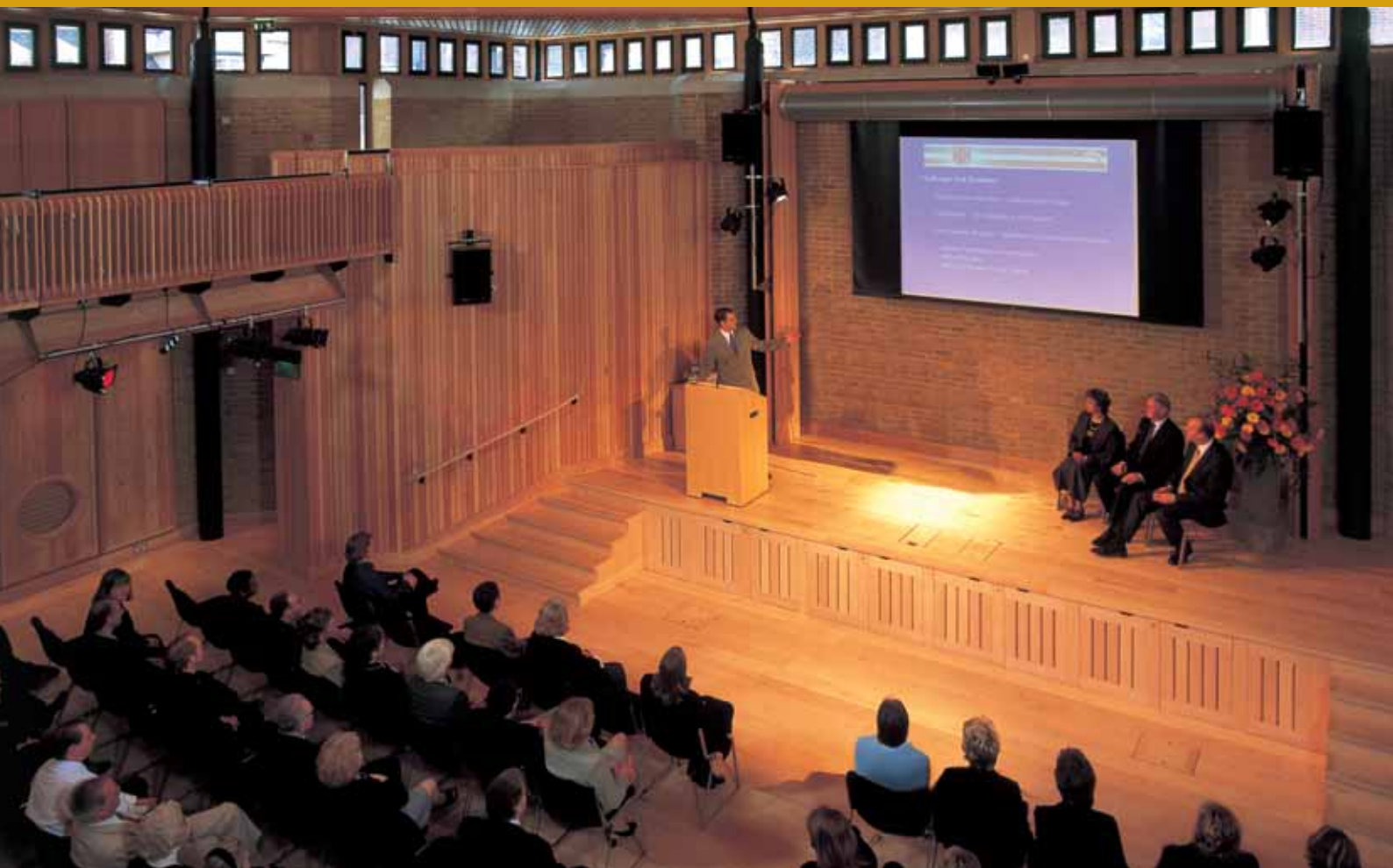

# CANTERBURY CATHEDRAL



**As part of the conference package, delegates will have free access to the Cathedral during their stay; to wonder at its beauty, learn about its rich history or perhaps to get inspiration.**

The Cathedral has a tradition of visitor welcome that dates back to monastic times when offering hospitality was an important part of life. Today, that tradition continues and we look forward to offering a warm welcome and first class hospitality to your delegates.

The Cathedral's history dates back to 597AD when St Augustine, sent by Pope Gregory the Great, became the first Archbishop and established his seat ('Cathedra') in Canterbury. In 1170 Archbishop Thomas Becket was murdered

in the Cathedral and ever since, the Cathedral has attracted thousands of pilgrims.

The Cathedral houses a Romanesque Crypt (11th century), a 12th century early Gothic Quire and a 14th century Nave. Beautiful medieval stained glass windows illustrate miracles and stories associated with St Thomas.

# HOW TO FIND US



**Canterbury is within easy reach of London, the Channel ports, Folkestone (Eurotunnel) and Ashford/Ebbsfleet International stations (Eurostar).**

## **By Train**

Canterbury West and Canterbury East train stations are both 0.5 miles away (10 min walk).

Journey time from London by train is approx 1 hour from London St Pancras.

## **By Road**

If you are using Satellite Navigation, you should enter the address 'Burgate, Canterbury' rather than using our postcode.

## **From London**

From M2 and M20 motorways, follow signs to A2 or Canterbury. Arriving in Canterbury, turn right

onto the ring road at Rheims Way roundabout. Keep the city walls on your left. After the 3rd (St George's) roundabout, turn left into Burgate.

## **From Dover/Folkestone**

Follow signs to Canterbury. You will arrive at the St George's roundabout. Turn right onto the ring road and then left into Burgate.

There is a Park and Ride site as you enter the city from this direction.

## **From Ashford**

Follow signs to Canterbury (A28). At Wincheap roundabout, turn right. Follow ring road. Turn left into Burgate.

There is a Park and Ride site as you enter the city from this direction.

## **Cathedral entrance gates**

- 7am – 6pm turn RIGHT into Postern Gate, just after Pub. ('B' on map).
- 6pm – 7am continue straight down Burgate, turning right into Christ Church Gate just after Starbucks ('A' on map).
- After 9pm – ring bell on left hand side of Christ Church Gate to gain entrance.

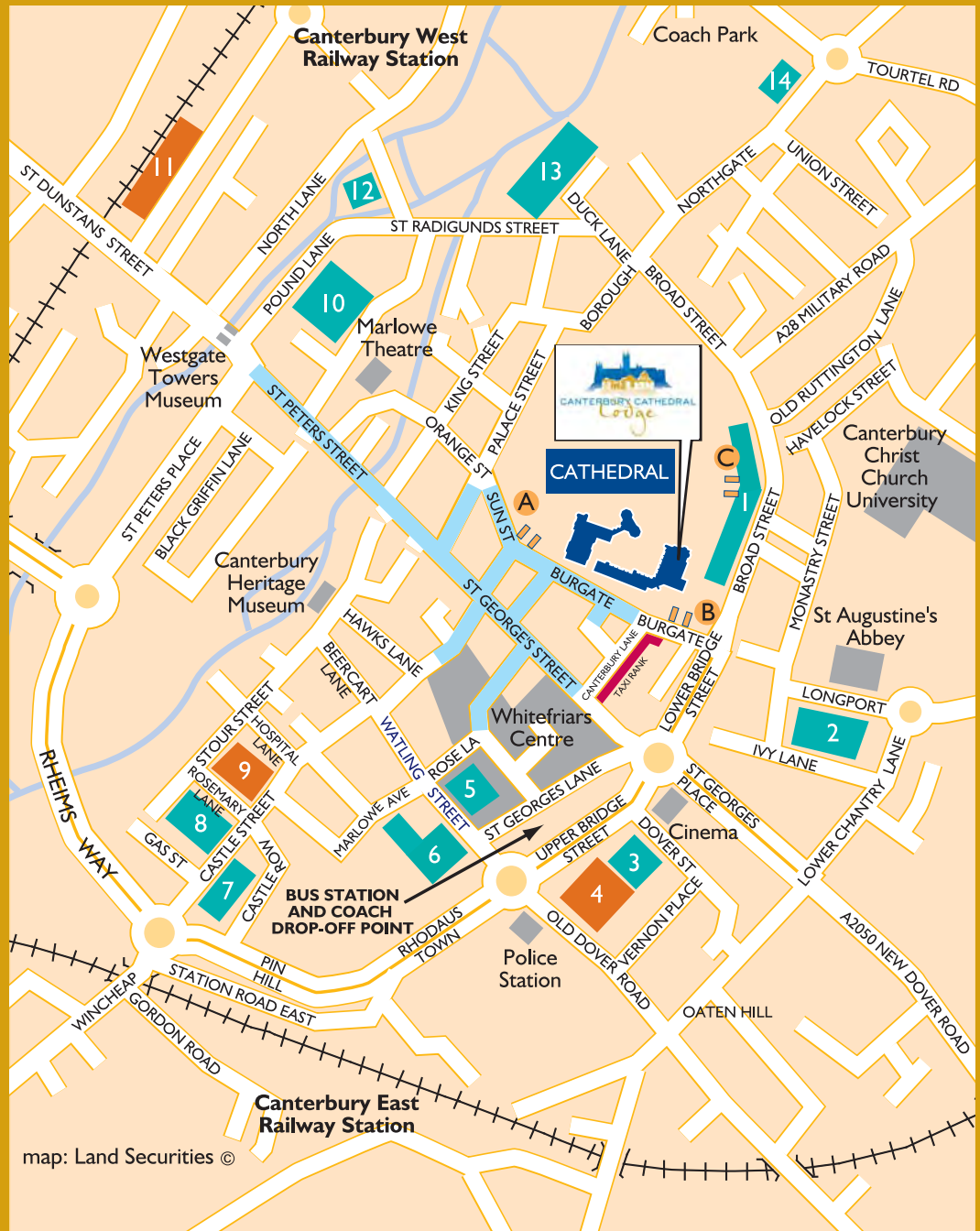
